Holistic Counseling for Individuals, Couples, Families Sliding Scale Fee (don't have to be Catholic)

M-F 9:00-5:00 Sliding scale fee but you have to ask about it. Don't have to be Jewish, nondenominational counseling
- 5). The Caring Clinic: 828-298-0186, 276 E. Chestnut St. Asheville M-F 8:30-4:30
Medicaid, sliding scale, assessments, evaluations, consultations and treatment for parents and children needing guidance how to work on and solve problems. They may also know of more resources.

CLOTHING, SHOES, FOOD:

- 1). Catholic Charities 828-255-0146 Weds. 12:15-4:00
Same info as above, they have clothes, food, hygiene products, diapers
- 2). Salvation Army 828-253-4723 Weds 1:30-3:30 Walk in to get Vouchers
They provide vouchers to get clothes every 90 days at their thrift store, and food every 60 days at their pantry. You have to bring birth certificates for all of you, plus your photo id and social security card.

3). Children First Community and Schools of Buncombe County, if your children attend Emma Elementary, Erwin Middle or Erwin High School. 828-252-4810

They have a clothing closet, food pantry, community garden, and \$assistance if you have shutoff notice or eviction notice.

4). Church of the Advocate: 828-253-9361 They have a Shoe Closet every Sunday 2:30 until supplies run out.
