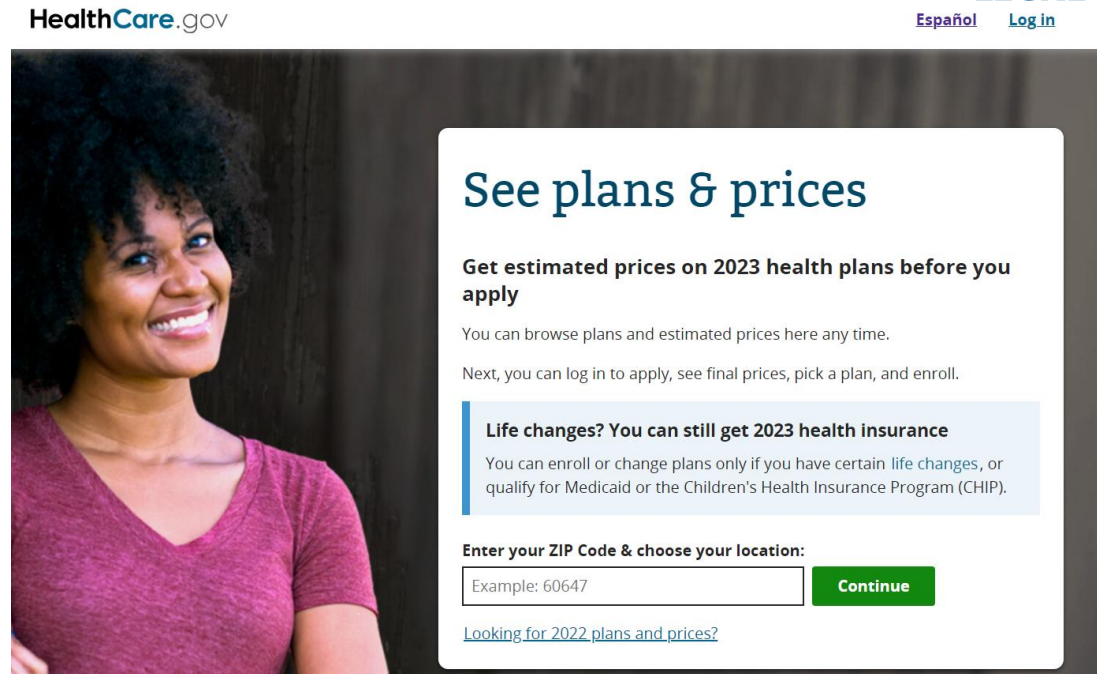
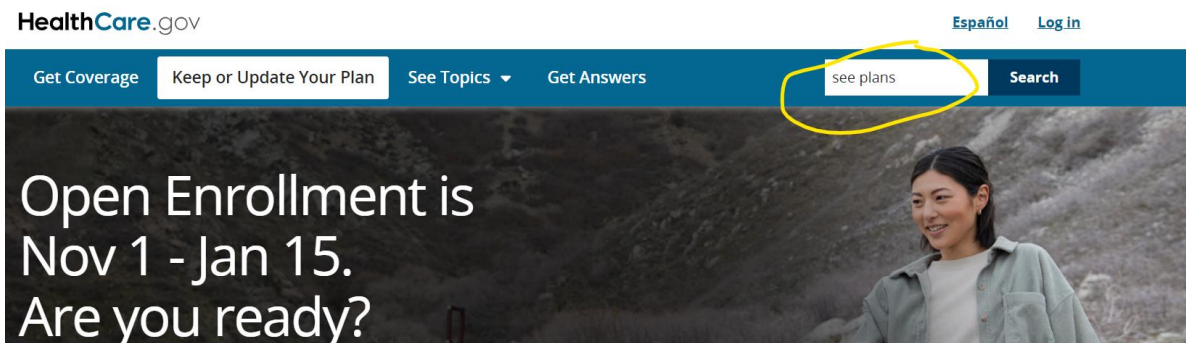


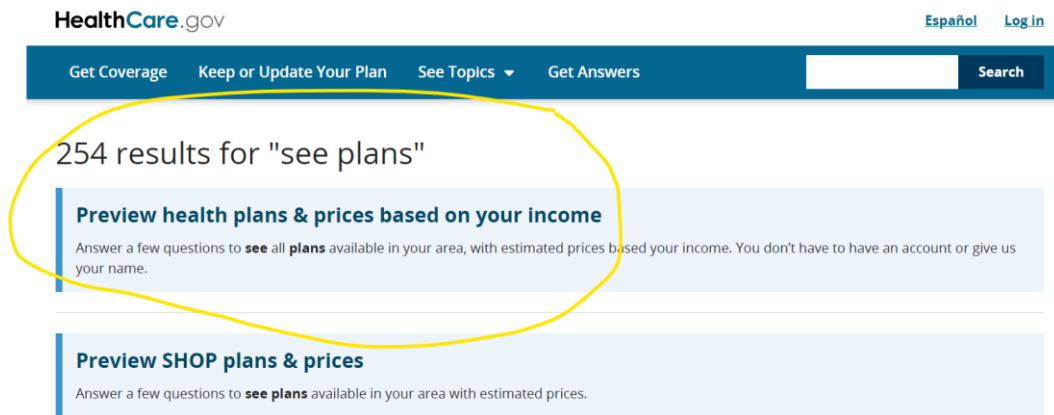
How to see a preview of what plans will be available to you when you apply on healthcare.gov



1. Go to www.healthcare.gov (if you have a healthcare.gov account, please make sure you are logged out of it to use this feature)
2. In the search bar on the main page, type in “see plans”



3. Select the first option, “preview health plans and prices based on your income”



4. Enter your zip code and click “continue”

5. Follow the steps to enter information about the members of your household and your expected income
