With Power of Attorney documents, immigrant parents can give legal authority to a friend or family member to care for their children and/or handle their financial affairs in the event of an emergency in which you were detained, deported, or otherwise unavailable, including:



Making decisions about your minor children's heath care, education, travel, and other aspects of their care



Making decisions about a disabled adult child's health care or other issues



Handling your financial affairs – access to your bank account, paying bills, and dealing with your vehicles, home, and other property



These powers of attorney do not transfer parental rights or custody and may be revoked at any time by the grantor
